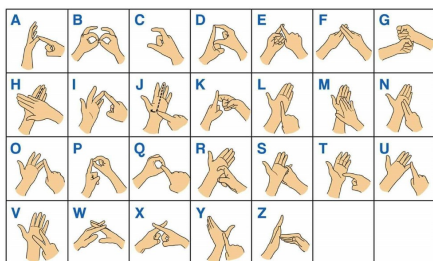

- **Royal blue PE shorts or skirt**

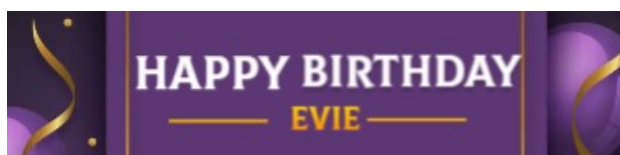

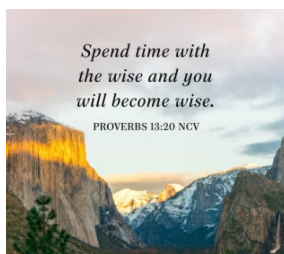
