Communication and Language (speaking and listening)

Retell a story once they have developed a deep familiarity with the text; some as exact repetition and some in their own words. Listen to and talk about selected non-fiction books and develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge and vocabulary.

Show and Tell—describe events in some detail. Learn a poem every week using poems from the **Poetry Basket.**

<u>Literacy</u> Retell by heart **Three Little Pigs**

Spell to write VC and CVC words independently using Phase 2 and 3 graphemes (writing). Read simple phrases and sentences made up of words with known letter—sound correspondences and a few exception words (reading).

Mathematics

Experience patterns which show a small group and 1 more. Become more familiar with the counting pattern beyond 20. Explore the composition of odd and even number looking at the 'shape' of these numbers,

Understanding the World

Comment on images of familiar situations in the past. Know about the life cycle of a human and can talk about how I have changed since I was a baby. Know that there are similarities and differences between others and myself. Know the name of some parts of the body that can be seen. Know how to keep their bodies healthy, e.g., eating healthy food, exercising, screen-time, oral health. Know the names of body parts. Know humans have five senses.
