Reminders about social media use

Less than half of the children in Red Kites have phones but many have devices that allow the children to contact other people through messaging or posting messages. Our local PCSOs visited Red Kites last week and talked to the children about taking care when posting/messaging and also what to do if they receive or see a post/message that they don't like.

Advice for parents from the PCSOs is:

- Remember to monitor your child's phone and if you can see messages/posts from another child to your child (or other children) that you do not think are appropriate, **do not contact the child directly by messaging them.**

Instead, contact the parent or school to help resolve the issue.

School parking for drop off and pick up

Please can we ask all parents and carers if you are dropping off or picking your child up by car that you are mindful of our neighbours, the black school gates and our pedestrians on the foot paths. Please do not park near the black school gates or on the pavements outside of school.
