We are particularly proud of how many sporting events our children have had the opportunity to participate in this academic year so far, from cricket for both KS1 and KS2, Multi-skills to stacking cups, Tennis to Tri Golf, Rugby to Football and that's before we even mention the unforgettable Cross Country, which is always a memorable experience for all of our Key stage 2 children! netball, dancing to football, walking and multisport.


