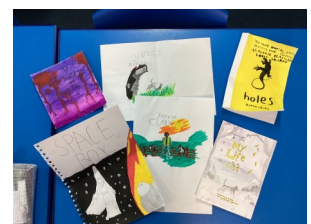
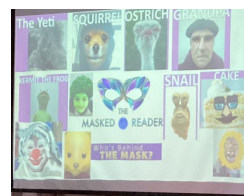
WELLBEING POSTER CHALLENGE!
